

CCC in person Church Service Guidelines



- On Sunday July 5, we will gather together again in person, at our Church building, inside the Fire Station, as well as Online as we have been doing.

Service Times:

Sunday service times have been adjusted:

We are adding a **9:00am** Worship Service until the gathering restrictions return back to normal or we have a much larger Sanctuary. All singles or families with last names from **A thru L** – please attend the 9am service. Doors will open at 8:30am; please be on time as service will end at 10am. We must have enough time to clean and prepare for the next service.

Our usual Worship Service time of **10:30am** will remain fixed for our on-line members. Last names from **M thru Z** – please attend the 10:30am service. You will not be able to enter the building until 10:20am, if you arrive early please remain in your car until 10:20am.

Screening

Healthcare professionals will be screening everyone before they enter the building from a station at the rear/ramp entrance. Temperature taking and other CDC guidelines will be observed for the safety of all members. If you or anyone in your household has or has recently had fever or flu-like symptoms...please stay safely at home. Watch & worship at 10:30 service.

Entering the Building

In order to keep everyone as safe as possible and adhere to government standards, we have a few things below that you need to remember. Please enter the building using the ramp at the back door.

- Ushers & hostesses will assist in helping you find seats for you & your family. Please follow their instructions in implementing the new seating procedure. Households will be allowed to sit together.
- We will continue to social distance ourselves. We will ensure there is a safe space between those who aren't from the same household.
- Please do not save seats. We want to make sure everyone has a chance to come in and find a seat quickly.

Restrooms

Restrooms are limited to 2 persons at the same time.

Parking Lot

Walking and car traffic will be complicated with two service times and new entrance doors. We will have parking attendants who will direct you. Please park and exit as directed even if it is not your preferred space or exit.

Face Mask

Please wear your facemask, if you forget your mask one will be provided. Try to keep your facemask up at all times. If you are a part of the Service and you are required to speak you may remove your mask during that time.

Tithes/Offering

We will still march forward to bring our tithes and offering unto the Lord. An offering basket will be placed in the front so we maintain social distance. You will still have all the electronic options to give.

Exiting the sanctuary

Exit the building at the front entrance that faces the street side, Nottingham Way. Collect for conversation outside the building to provide social distance and smooth traffic flow.

General precautions

- It will be difficult not to shake hands & hug each other, but please for the safety of everyone, abstain from doing so.
- Please still shout, jump, praise, worship, dance, allow the Holy Spirit to have His way in your heart just be aware and respectful of other's personal space.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the Sanctuary.
- The Sanctuary will be cleaned and sanitized after each service.

Altar Call

Altar Call will still be given. Anyone who desires to come to the altar can. If you prefer to remain in your seat and pray that is okay. Be mindful of others personal space. No one should lay hands on anyone except if instructed to do so by the Pastor.
